For Grandparents and Relatives Raising Children

Grandparents raising grandchildren -- though it can sound somewhat charming, it can be difficult for families -- especially without the proper resources.

The topic of kinship caregiving doesn't generate much public attention — even though about 100,000 grandparents in Ohio are currently raising their grandchildren, with 39% of those households not having a parent present.

"The main problem is most people don't even recognize it as an issue," according to Angela Provenzano, a second year student in the doctorate of occupational therapy program at Ohio State. "It's like, 'Oh, they're just taking care of their family. It's not a big deal; that's what they're supposed to do.' But it's really so much more than that." If you are a grandparent or relative raising your grandchild and you are looking for support, you can find it in Lucas County.

The support group is called 'Kinship Navigator Program- Supporting grandparents and relatives raising Children'. Grandparents meet in a casual and welcoming environment, offering education and support to grandparents who are raising grandchildren. Grandparents have the opportunity to meet other caregivers, develop a network of support and receive information about resources.

Jones Leadership Academy of Business- is the place to be for students who envision themselves as future business or community leaders. This High School has a career tech focus on a business-themed curriculum that includes marketing, finance and supply chain management.

The Toledo Pre-Medical & Health Science Academy- The Toledo Pre-Medical & Health Science Academy is a four-year high school created through a partnership between Toledo Public Schools and ProMedica for students who are passionate about a career serving others in healthcare.

Toledo Early College- offers a college preparatory program for students in 7th -12th grades that focuses on college readiness and 21st century skills. The curriculum is designed to accelerate students into college courses at The University of Toledo.

Toledo Technology Academy of Engineering- is focused on engineering and manufacturing science technologies. Every student participates in hands-on learning in labs starting with Lego Labs in 7th grade.


